At 6962m, Argentina's Aconcagua is the highest peak outside the Himalayas but you don't need to be a climber to get to the top. Thousands of trekkers travel every year to conquer it and this comprehensive guidebook has all the information they need to take.

The ascents of Aconagua described are the Normal (or Horcones Valley) Route and the Vacas Valley (or Polish Glacier) Route – the two most popular and non-technical ascents. A selection of other treks around Santiago and Aconocagua, and throughout the southern Andes, are also outlined.

This second edition has been fully updated. A day trip to the Maipo Volcano has also now been added to the many things to do from Mendoza.

THE AUTHOR

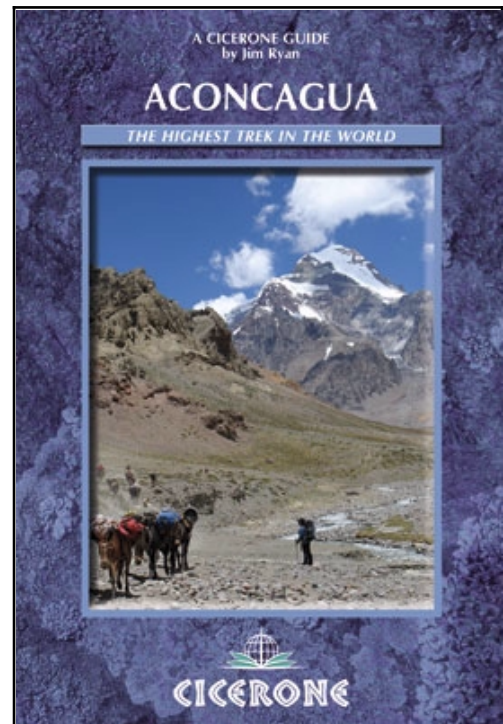
